

# We're going on a #LegacyBearHunt



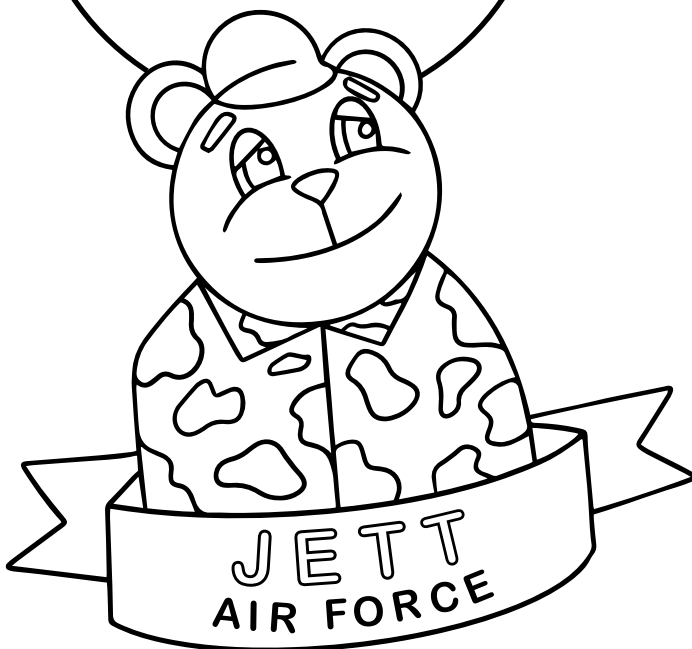
Whether you're visiting the shops or doing some daily exercise, keep an eye out for bears hidden everywhere on your walk!
